

# Simkin House Fund

## **Greetings.**

The Simkin House Fund is here to support Youth Ministry throughout the Diocese of Auckland. If you have any questions after reading this brochure, please contact the Diocesan Youth Facilitator (the contact details are inside).

## **History.**

The Fund was established in 1993 with the proceeds of sale of Simkin House on Waiheke Island. As goodwill the interest generated is split equitably between Anglican Youth Ministries (Diocese of Auckland) and Tai Tokerau Youth Council (Te Hui Amorangi ki te Tai Tokerau) and used to fund grass/flax roots youth ministry.

## **The committee.**

The Committee consists of three members - the Diocesan Youth Facilitator, a representative of Youth Synod and a representative of the Council for Christian Nurture.

## **Funding round dates.**

Each year there are two funding rounds. Applications need to be received on or before these dates: 1st March and 1st September.

## **Application criteria.**

All applications meeting the following criteria will be considered:

- From a person or group connected to the Anglican Diocese of Auckland.
- Relates to Youth Ministry.
- Provides the requested information.
- Is within funds available.
- Received by the deadline.

## **Fund Priorities.**

The Simkin House Fund gives priority to funding for camps, retreats, holiday programmes and youth events over the purchase of equipment.

## Information to consider.

### The amount of funds available.

Each year the amount of money available to distribute varies. As a guide the total amount available to distribute in each funding round is approximately \$3500.

### The purchase of equipment.

Simkin House Fund prefers not to supply funds for the purchase of equipment. When it does, the equipment is purchased and owned by Anglican Youth Ministries. The equipment is then loaned to the group for the duration of their project.

### Long term funding.

The Simkin House Fund will not support on-going projects indefinitely. However the Simkin House Fund will help groups establish projects. Applicants need to be aware that each grant is given on a one off basis and is not a promise or an indication of future funding. Every application in each funding round will be considered on it's individual merits.

### After the Grant.

If Simkin House Fund approves your application, you have a responsibility to:

- Provide Proof of Appropriate Spending (e.g. invoices and bank statements).
- Provide a Summary Report of Your Project (photos would be nice).
- Return any equipment that was purchased with grant money.

### An appropriate source of funds.

Please remember to consider the criteria on the front page. Simkin House Fund is intended to fund grass/flax roots youth ministry through relatively small grants. For a list of other funding sources visit [www.aym.org.nz/freemoney](http://www.aym.org.nz/freemoney).
